Creating interest among young indigenous people to sustain indigenous knowledge and cultural heritage in the communities by discourse with elder consultants.

Discussing possible further projects with the peoples of the Amur region.

Developing strategies to overcome political restrictions regarding collaborative projects with indigenous communities in Russia (in Russia).
